BURNED AREA Potential Hazards Include:

> Flash Flooding, and Debris Flows Trees may have been weakened from fire damage and may fall at any time.

Loose Rocks,

- Avoid area during high winds
- Be alert for falling trees
- Do not linger around large burned trees

Flash floods and debris flows may occur anytime.

Avoid area during heavy rain

- The Danner Pass and Lookout Mountain Trails were greatly damaged by the Cameron Peak Fire in 2020 and subsequent flood events.
- The Canyon Lakes Ranger District, partners, and volunteers were able to reconstruct these trails with the help of Colorado Parks and Wildlife Off-Highway Vehicle **Grant Funds.**
- These trails are technically challenging and should only be used by experienced riders.
- This trail system serves as one of the only motorized singletrack opportunities on the Northern Front Range. You can help to keep these trails open by riding safely, respecting private property and other trail users, obtaining your CPW OHV registration, and obeying all rules and regulations.

To operate a off-highway motorcycle in Colorado, 📝 the following sound limits must be met:

96dB(A) if manufactured after 1/1/1998

99dB(A) if manufactured before 1/1/1998




Colorado Off-Highway Vehicle Sticker Required by Law

In state or out-of-state OHVs, this applies to you.

Before your adventure begins, familiarize yourself with Colorado's Off-Highway Vehicle Program to ensure your safety and enjoyment as a responsible rider. Vehicle registrations, renewals and out-of-state vehicle permits fund trail maintenance and construction, trailheads, parking areas, trail signs, maps, and land acquisition.


